### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT - DECEMBER 18, 2024

➤ Our current enrollment is at 325 students. Registration for Preschool is February 3-7.

- ➤ Parent teacher interviews held November 20<sup>th</sup> using on-line booking of appointments. Teachers reported an increase in parent participation.
- November 28<sup>th</sup> Magic Show for students with emphasis on mental health and wellness.
- ➤ Playventures Cycle 1 students. 10 week program that focused on playing games to foster self-confidence, self-awareness, team spirit, communication, focus and emotional balance in our students. Last session was December 10.
- The Recess Success program, Provide grade 1 and 2 students with organized games, will begin in January. This program will be facilitated by 20 grade 5 and 6 students. These students will follow a schedule and be on the junior side during morning and afternoon recess (not during lunch).
  - The grade 5 and 6 students who have been chosen participated in 2 workshops, led by Dynamix. The workshops were held Thursday December 5 & 12, from 12:40-2:40.

- ➤ Community Development Projects: CDA. Melyssa, secured \$10 000 from RRM (Réseau réussite Montréal) to promote learning of French language in our school. \$3000.00 allotted for French games and \$7000.00 for animation of science program in French once a week.
